- Assist computer projects related to the storage, retrieval and indexing of genealogical information

The GCG has a committee elected at Annual General Meetings, responsible for:

- Sponsoring and supporting the establishment of “**subgroups**”
- Publishing a quarterly magazine - **GenCom News** - dispatched in March, June, September and December
- Liaising with our parent body: **The New Zealand Society of Genealogists**
